WHERE: Argentina

WHEN: 2011 or 2012.

TERMS: This is a fabulous two day hunt for two hunters in the scenic wilds of Argentina for Duck and Dove. This guarantees healthy and controlled hunting pressure. Also, they have other hunting areas northwards, if weather conditions precluded taking a sufficient number of ducks. Moreover, they offer great areas to shoot snipe, partridges and pigeons. The numerous varieties of ducks

These birds move around during the course of the day, which makes it possible to hunt them usually from dawn to 10:30 a.m., and in the afternoon from 4:30 p.m. to dusk.
